

Extended Minerals Statement

As an electronic passive component manufacturer, we require our suppliers to use conflict-free minerals. Our raw materials vendors have established specific supply chain steps and provide certifications that certain metals are conflict-free conflict minerals. This includes the six minerals currently outlined in the Extended Mineral Reporting Template (EMRT):

- Cobalt (Co)
- Copper (Cu)
- Graphite (allotrope of Carbon)
- Lithium (Li)
- Mica (SiO₄)
- Nickel (Ni)

Fair-Rite conducts periodic reviews with our vendors to ensure that they are in compliance with this policy and we obtain certifications from these vendors that their metal supplies are conflict-free conflict minerals.

Fair-Rite's metal raw materials are sourced from all over the world, including reputable global financial institutions. Based on our knowledge, we are confident that the materials used in our manufacturing do not contain the substances listed above that originate as conflict minerals.

In our vigilant environment, we work meticulously to ensure that these are conflict-free conflict minerals. We continually monitor our supply chain to ensure that this policy is strictly adhered.
